


Fast Facts – Expectation versus Reality



Selection

Looking at selection:

- No respondents said they were able to do it in 3 months
- 25% took longer than a year

Survey Overview

- Purpose: what is the AMS/CRM selection process like for clients, vendors, and consultants?
- Launched in October 2021 and closed in December 2021
- 237 respondents across 73 associations, 16 solution providers, and 13 consulting groups
- Five participant groups
 - *Association Staff
 - *Solution Vendors

- *Association Management Company Representative
- *Consultants

What do the organization and respondent demographics tell us about the survey results?

- Organization Size by employee count
 - 0-10
 - 11-50
 - 51+
- Function Manager/Director
- Department Membership & CEO/ED/COO
- Role Project Manager, Executive Sponsor, and "All of the above"



How long were survey respondents on legacy systems before deciding to select a new AMS/CRM?



What types of choices were made that impacted selection decisions?

- Reasons for selecting a new system
- Number of months between system selection and implementation
- Hiring vs Not hiring a Consultant





How did organization size drive the reasons behind seeking out a new AMS/CRM solution?



Does a longer system selection timeline mean shorter or longer implementation timelines?



What do the survey results reveal about the decision to use or not use a Consultant during the system selection process?



How do the challenges of system selection differ based on organization size?
